

Roll-Away Nesting Box - Quick Start Guide

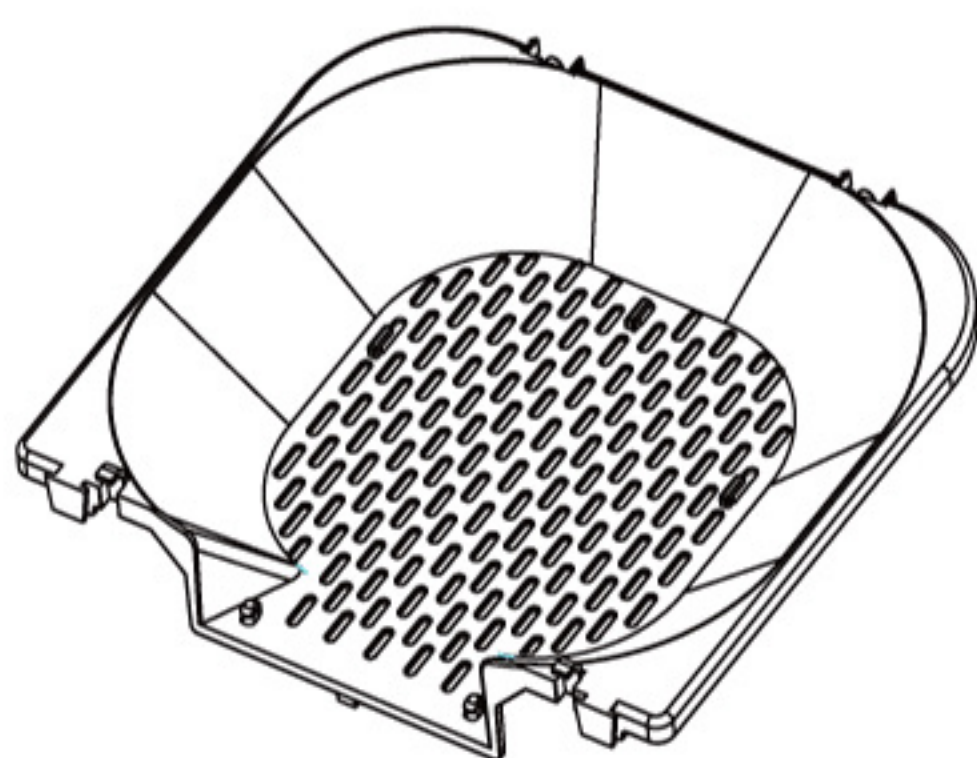
Product Features

- **Clean Egg Collection:** Sloped, enclosed area prevents contamination (dirt, droppings, pecking).
- **Durable Construction:** High-quality ABS plastic for long-term reliability.
- **Adjustable Slope:** 2-position setting adapts to egg sizes/coop setups.
- **Easy Maintenance:** Bottom drainage holes enable dry, hygienic upkeep.
- **Comfortable Nesting:** Removable pads (soft, clean) – no interference with egg roll-out.

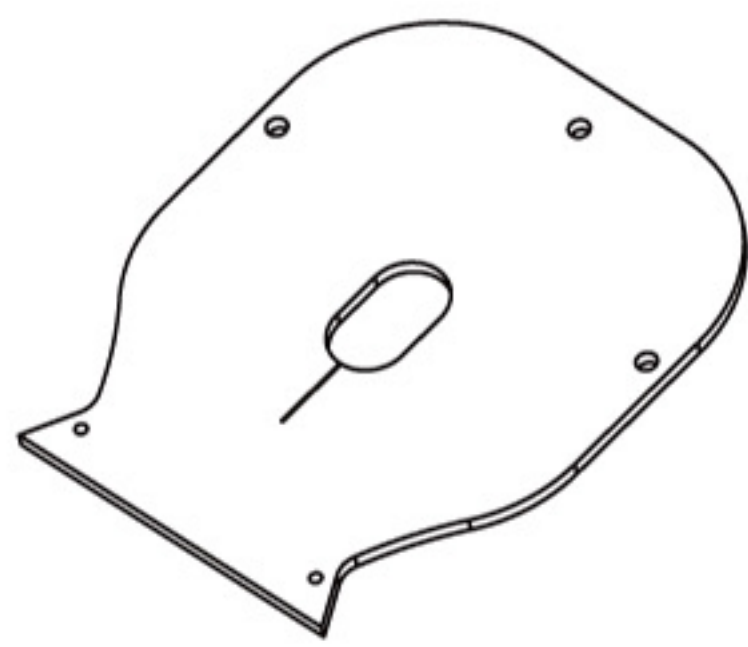
Compatibility & Specifications

- Fits most standard/homemade boxes (internal dimensions: $\geq$ Length12" $\times$ Width14" $\times$ Height12").
- Ideal for small/medium breeds: Silkie, Amberlink, Leghorn, Barred Rock.
- Egg entrance (5.5cm): Accommodates small – large eggs.
- Capacity: 5 – 7 eggs per box.

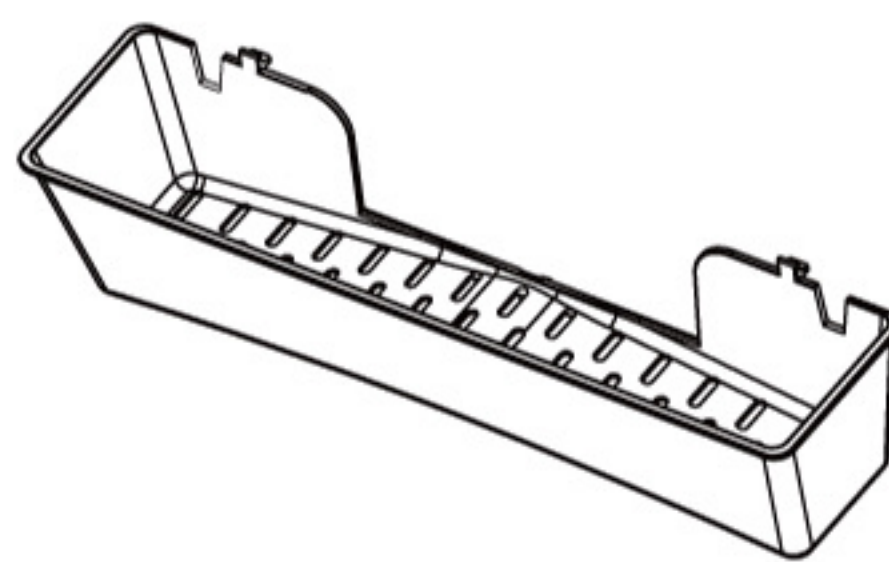

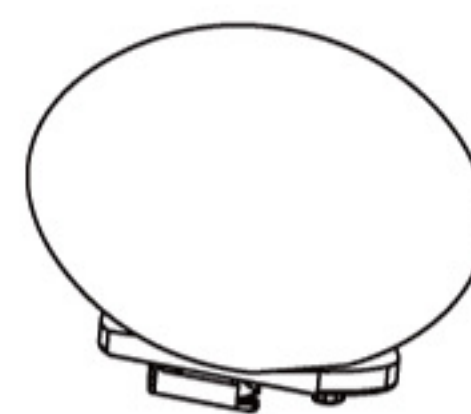

Usage Guidelines

- **Hygiene:** Keep box dry (damp = mold/bacteria risk). Clear blocked drains/channels regularly.
- **Space Allocation:** 1 box per 3 – 4 hens (prevents overcrowding).
- **Diet Recommendation:** Provide calcium-rich layer feed + fresh water for strong eggshells.
- **On first use,** chickens may scratch/peck nest pads out of instinct (causing surface tears that block egg rolling), but this behavior stops entirely after 2 – 3 replacements as they adapt to the pads and surroundings.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Hens not using nesting box?

Put fake eggs (secured with double-sided tape) in the box. Hens copy each other—if some use it, others will follow.

How often to clean?

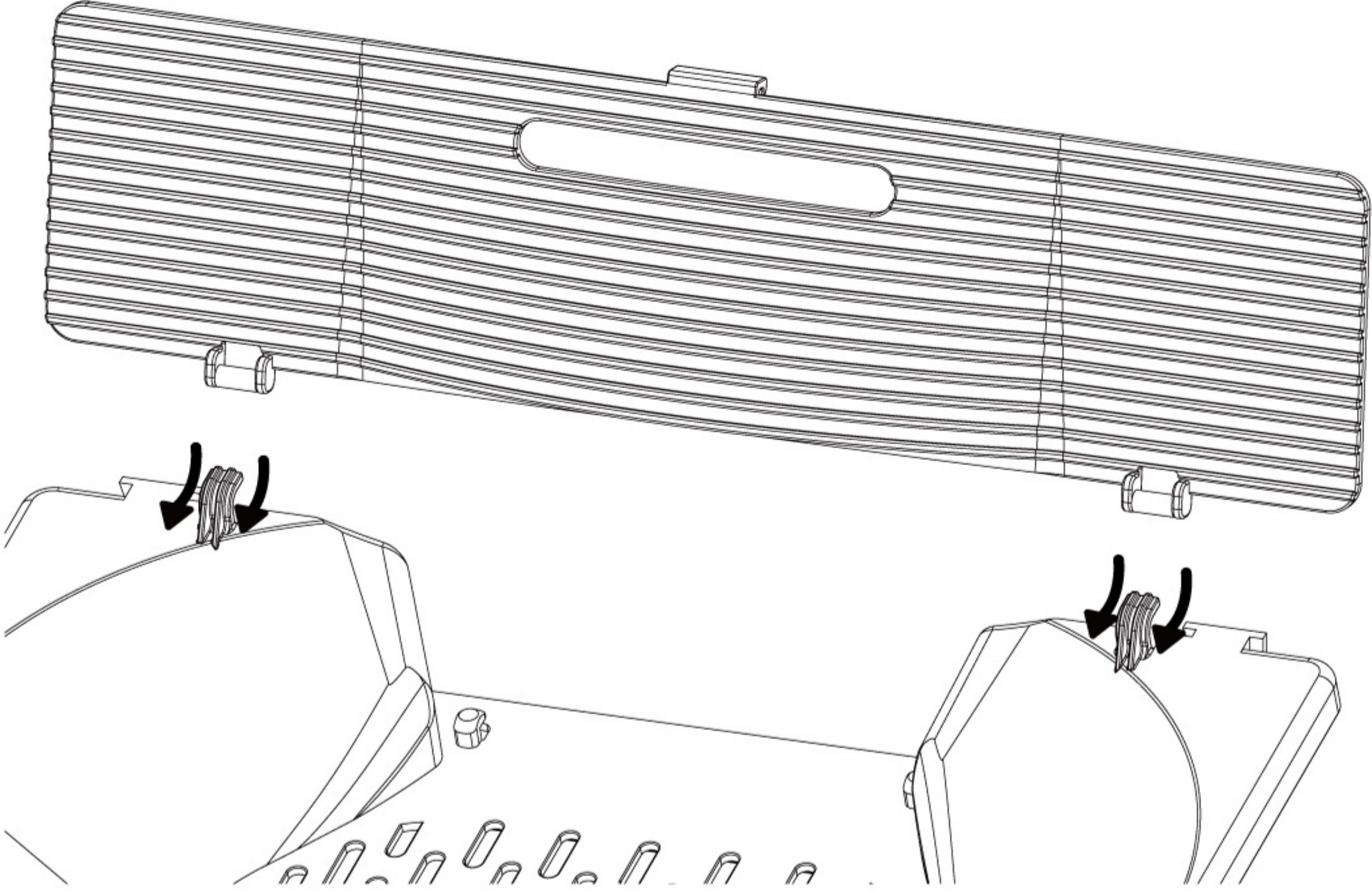
Clean weekly (more if needed): Rinse with water, remove debris.

Can I use straw/bedding?

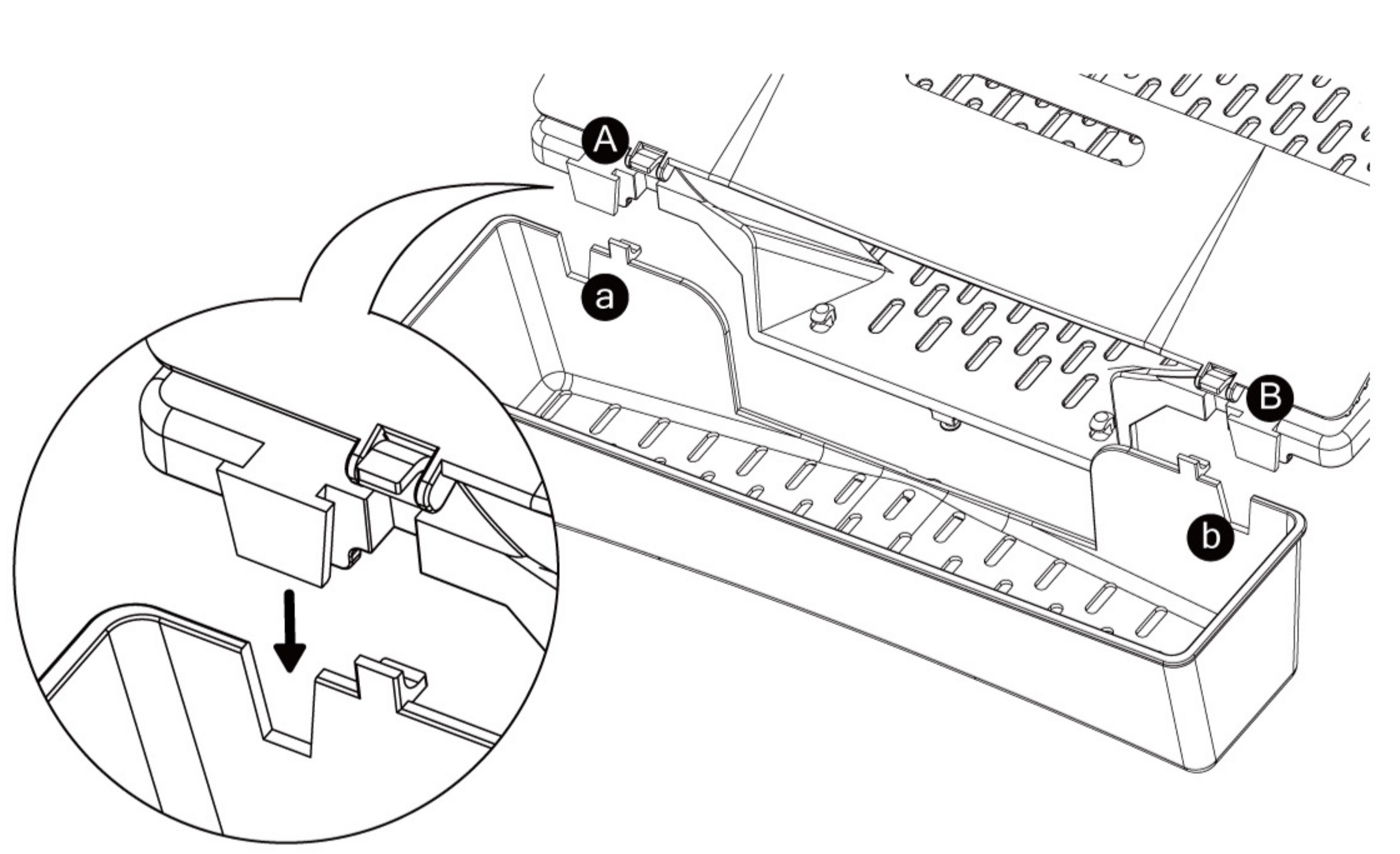
Each box has 3 nesting pads. You can add a small amount of straw/wood shavings (just don't block egg rolling).

Installation & Use

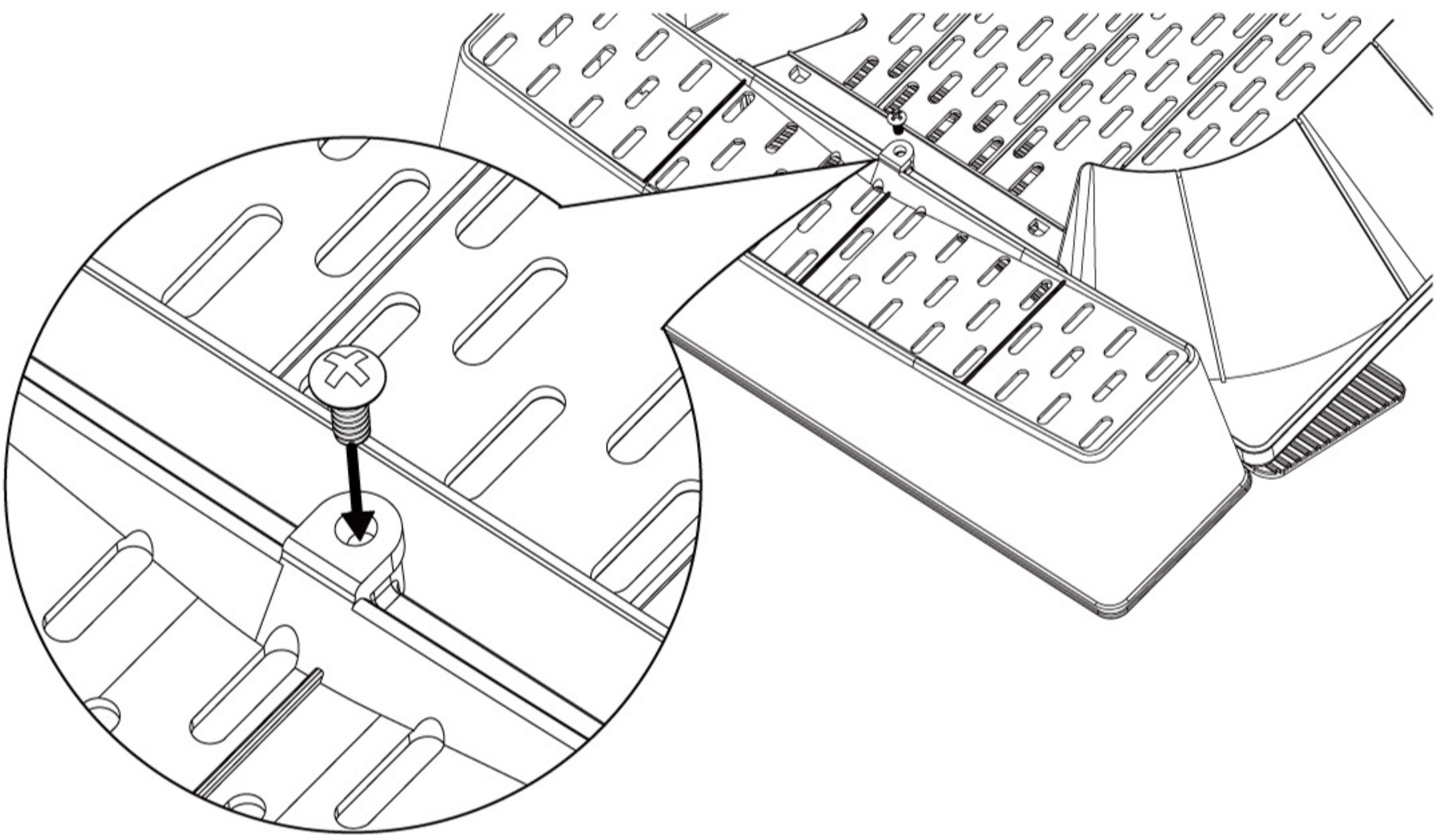
- 1** Fit the lid into the matching slot on the curved section of the egg-laying nest.



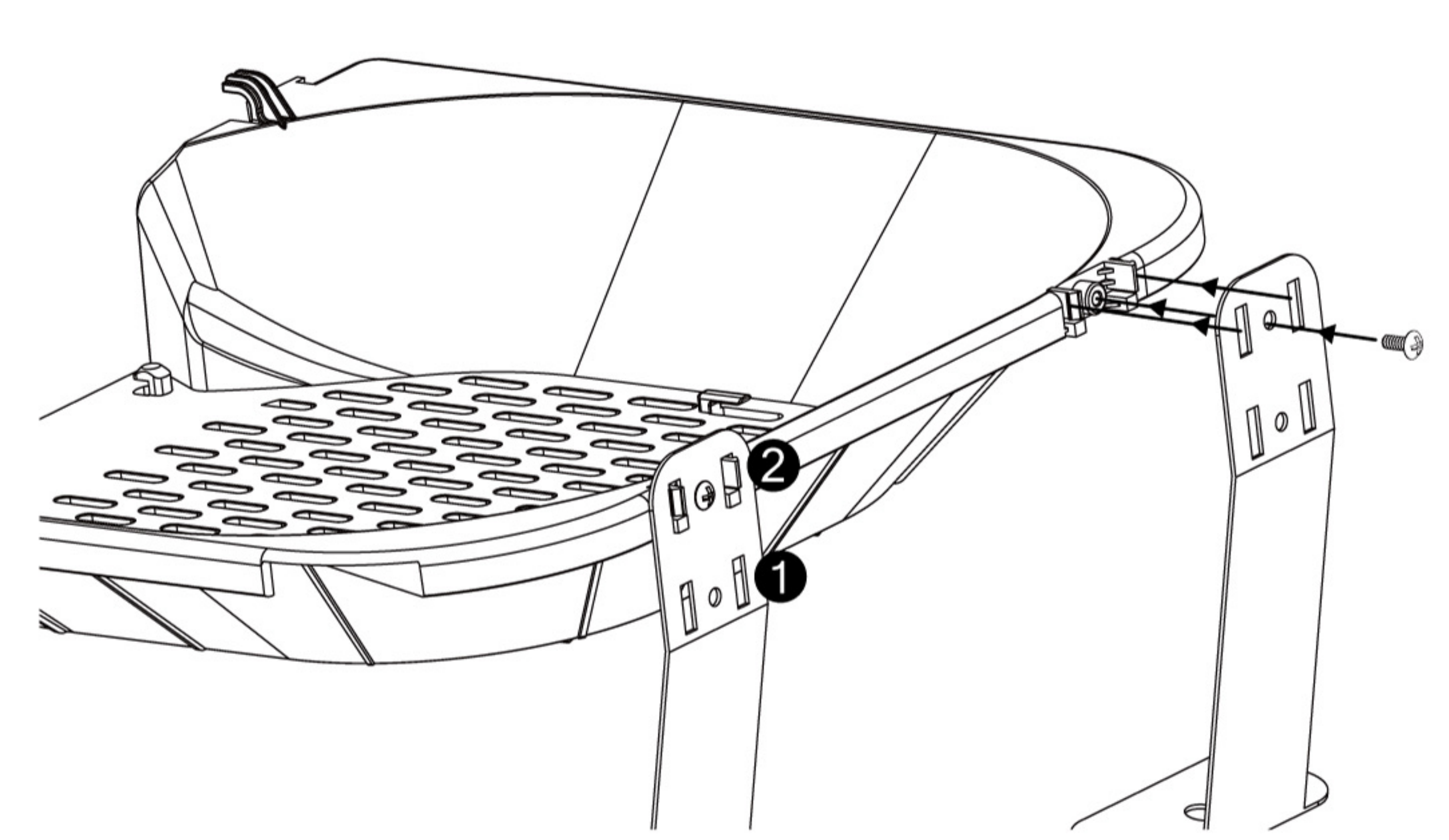
- 2** Push the wedge-shaped tabs of the egg-laying nest firmly into the slots on the egg collection box.



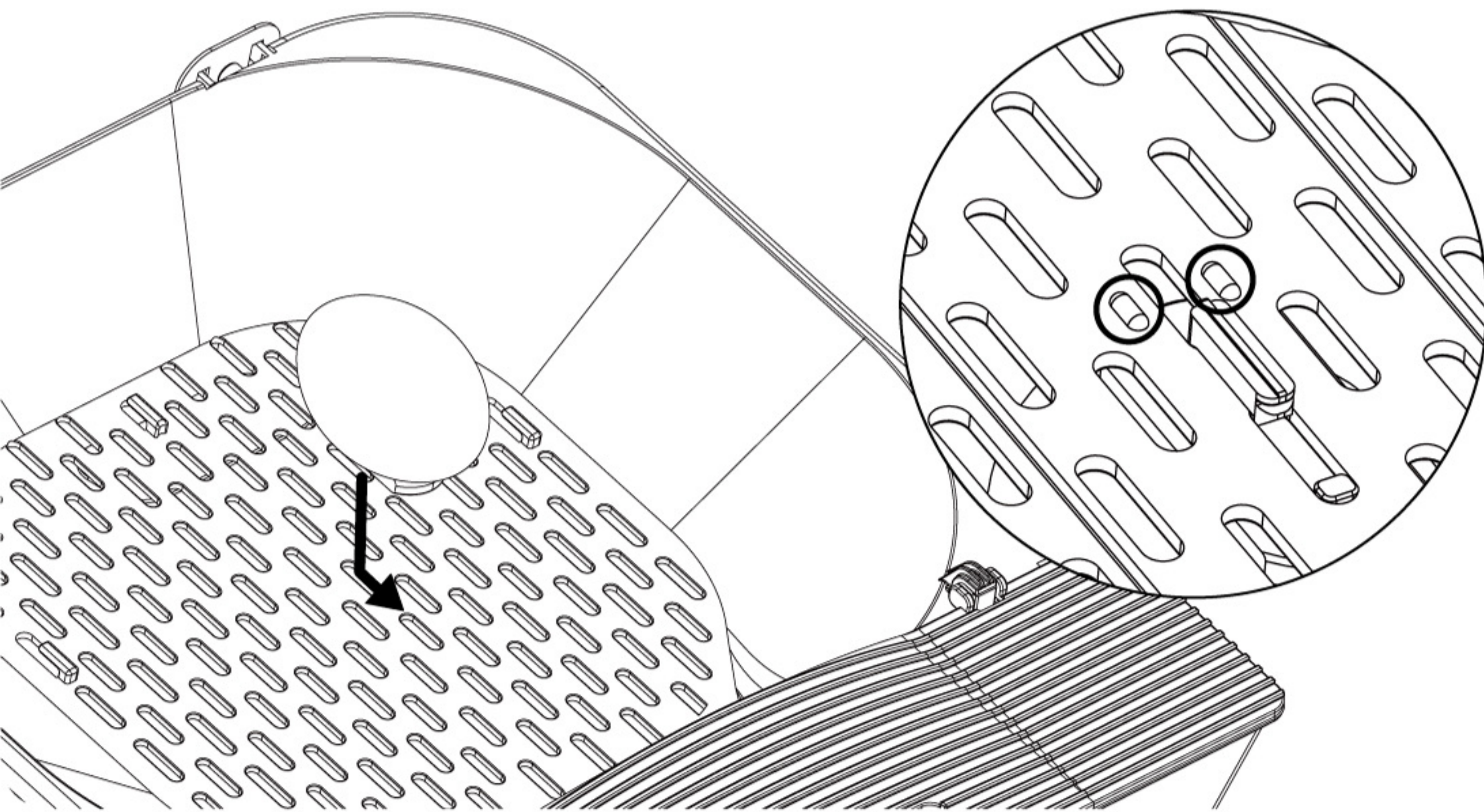
- 3** Fasten the screws from the back to lock the egg-laying nest and egg collection box securely together.



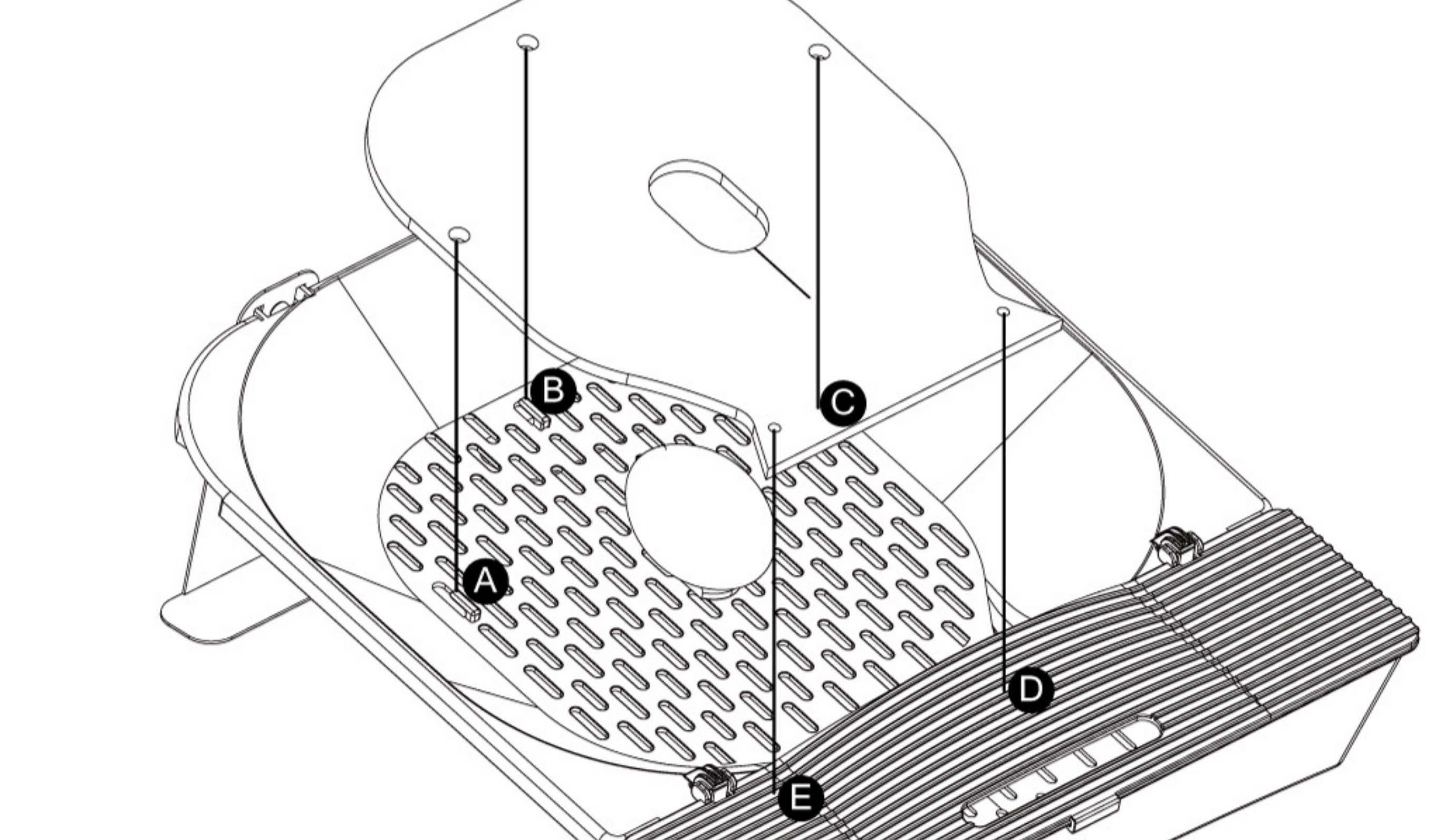
- 4** Fasten the bracket to the edge of the nest with screws and tighten firmly. Height is adjustable in 2 levels (Level 1/Level 2).



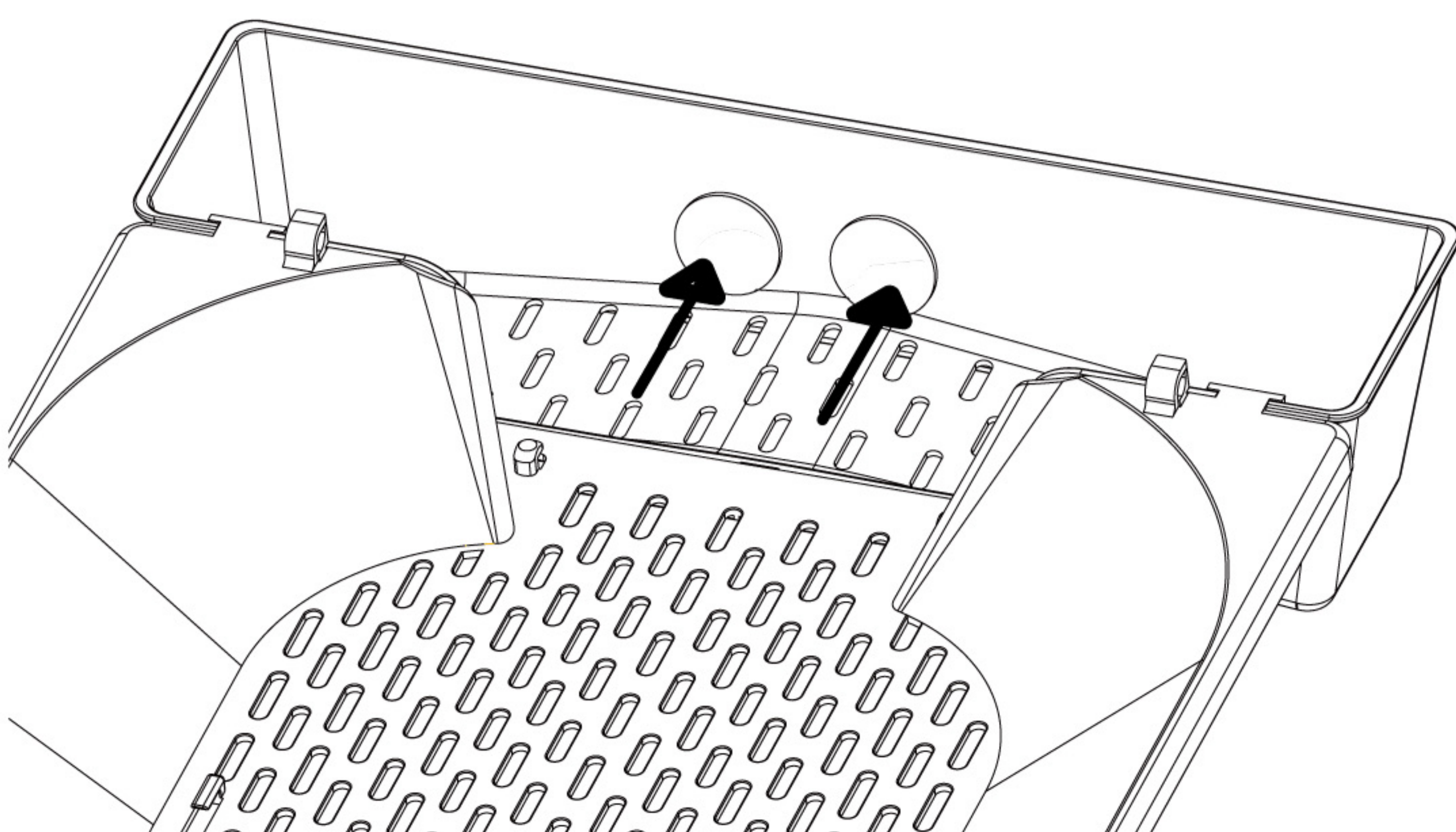
- 5** Place the dummy egg into the central hole of the incubation basin. Align the two small protrusions on the back of the egg with the mounting holes, then press firmly to secure it in place.



- 6** Align the holes on the nest pad with the marked positions (A-E) on the bottom of the nesting box, then insert and lock to prevent sliding.



- 7** Stick the EVA foam pad onto the inner wall of the collection box to cushion and protect eggs from cracks or damage.



- 8** Final assembly overview.
